Welcome to Spring!

With the spring weather upon us, as we start to feel a bit more warmth in the sun, we can see the buds appearing and the landscape coming back into colour. These themes of new life can be found in many <u>religious festivals</u> and <u>celebrations</u> at this time of year.

The 40 acts approach to Lent, which focusses more on generosity than austerity, is a useful <u>resource</u>. Sat 2nd April marks the start of Ramadan this year. Islamic festivals differ from many religious events, because the Muslim calendar follows the lunar, rather than the solar cycle. It has 354 days, meaning it is 11 days shorter than the Western (Gregorian) year, resulting in festivals moving earlier each year. So, Muslim festivals are not seasonally related.
