### New Agreed Syllabus for 2024

Devon, Torbay and Plymouth SACREs will be bringing in a new RE agreed syllabus from Sept 2024, so watch out for developments here. The changes will be 'light touch', but will add more features to enable teachers to plan great teaching on religious and non-religious worldviews: more diversity within and across worldviews, more reference to local lived experience, more reference to pupils' own personal worldview perspectives.
